First, you will be scheduled for a screening visit (about 45 minutes) and then, if you meet the program's educational needs, you will be matched with a student who will provide your dental care. Dental cleaning will be scheduled for three hour appointments and you may need to return two, three or more times to have everything completed depending on the complexity of your dental health needs. Children typically do not need a screening visit.


